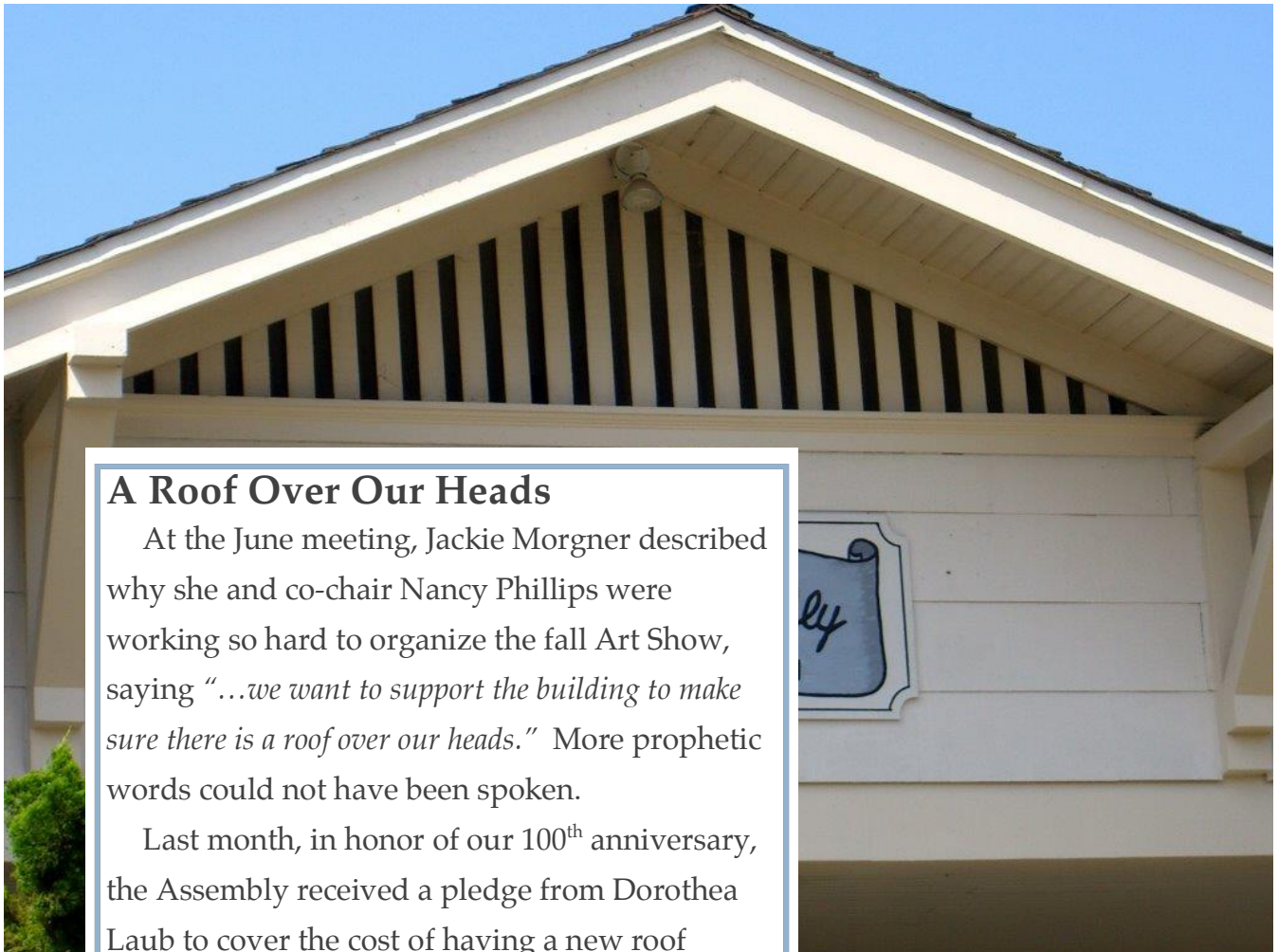

## Recipe of the Month

### Glazed Orange Coconut Cake

This orange-infused cake comes all the way from a little Micronesian island called Kosrae and a local named Katrina. Her version is called Juicy Orange Cake, which pretty much sums up the incredible flavor.

#### **Cake:**

2-1/2 cups all-purpose flour  
1-1/2 cups granulated sugar  
3/4 cup finely shredded, unsweetened coconut  
2 tsp. baking powder  
2 tsp. baking soda  
1/2 tsp. salt  
1 cup coconut milk  
1/2 cup vegetable oil  
2 eggs  
1 tsp. vanilla  
1 cup fresh orange juice (4-5 oranges)  
1 tsp. finely grated orange rind

#### **Orange glaze and garnish:**

2 cups powdered sugar  
1/4 cup fresh orange juice (1 orange)  
Toasted coconut chips (optional)

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease and flour a bundt pan.

Combine flour and next 5 ingredients (flour through salt)

In a separate bowl, combine coconut milk, oil, eggs, vanilla and orange juice and rind. Pour into dry ingredients and mix until smooth. Pour into prepared pan.

Bake 35-40 minutes until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out dry. Let cool completely before removing from pan.

To prepare glaze:

Whisk together powdered sugar and orange juice. If there are little lumps, let glaze sit 30 minutes, until they dissolve. Pour glaze over completely cooled cake. Sprinkle coconut chips on top, if using. Serves 20.
