Recipe of the Month

Our former hospitality Chair, Myrna Bossler, was responsible for many goodies at our past meetings. Here she shares one of her recipes with us.

NO-BAKE FUDGY COCONUT COOKIES

- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 2/3 cup 2% milk
- 1/2 cup baking cocoa
- 1/2 cup butter, cubed
- 1/2 t. salt
- 1/3 cup creamy peanut butter
- 1 t. vanilla
- 2 cups quick cooking oats
- 1 cup flaked coconut

In a large saucepan, combine the first 5 ingredients. Bring to a boil, stirring constantly. Cook and stir for 3 minutes.

Remove from heat; stir in peanut butter and vanilla until blended. Stir in oats and coconut. Drop mixture by tablespoons onto waxed paper-lined baking sheets. Refrigerate until set.
