Thanks to every member who voted on the ballot measure to amend and restate our Articles of Incorporation. We had an excellent turnout and the vote carried unanimously. We have submitted the ballot results to the Assembly attorney and are now in the process of submitting a request to have our IRS non-profit designation changed to a 501©3. If the request is approved, it means any person or group making a donation, gift, bequest or grant to the Assembly's programs or building restoration would be able to receive a tax deduction equivalent to the value of the contribution. The restated Articles of Incorporation do not impact our meetings, programs, membership rules, events, or rental program. This vote affects our tax status only. 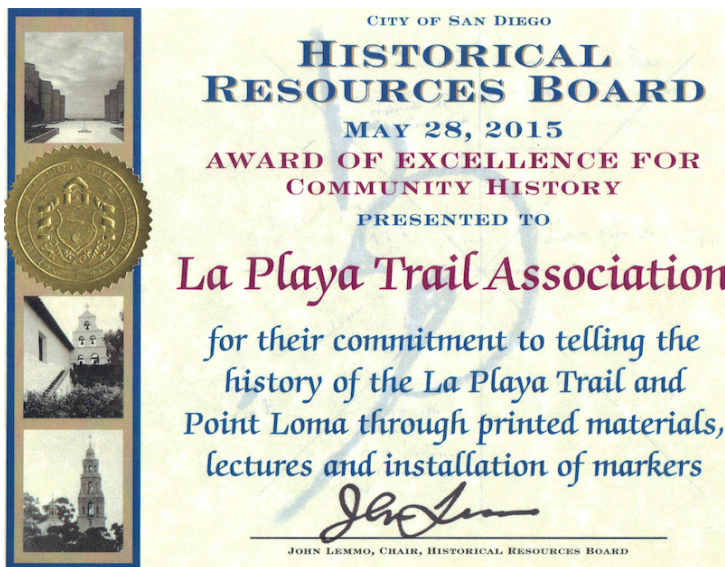
We have 58 renewals and 2 new members. Follow up letters were in the mail on June 25.
