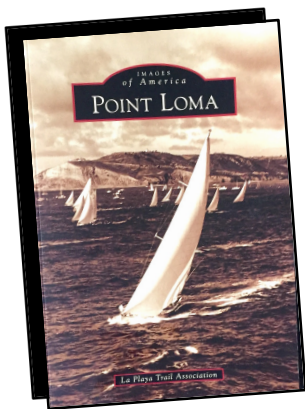
Doors open at 3:30, presentation follows.
