## Our Good Friend

Some years ago, during the early revitalization of the Assembly building, Dorothea Laub asked well-known architect Dick Lareau to visit the building. The goal was to focus on historic preservation, yet make the building more usable. Dusty blueprints of the original building by architect J.B. Stamford from the early 1900's were even available for review.



A handicapped accessible front door was most important among the many things needing attention. Dick showed Dorothea a previous ADA compatible ramp he had created. The talents of landscape architect Ned Daugherty were added and an attractive ramp with beautiful plantings was born.

Historically knowledgeable and perpetually generous with his time and skills, Dick will be 90 years young this October. He has been continuously involved with Point Loma leadership through the Point Loma Association, PLNU and local planning boards. He is renowned for his passion as an architectural documentarian. For many years his famous "Before and After" slide show of our PL neighborhood historical-architectural evolution was the highlight of numerous PLA fundraising dinners. Married to Victory Lareau, our Assembly interior decorator, for over 50 years they are parents of 4 and grandparents to 9.
