She leaves behind her loving husband, Steve, daughter, Libby, and son, Walter and his family.

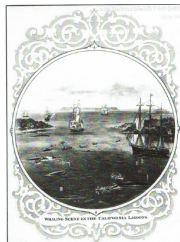

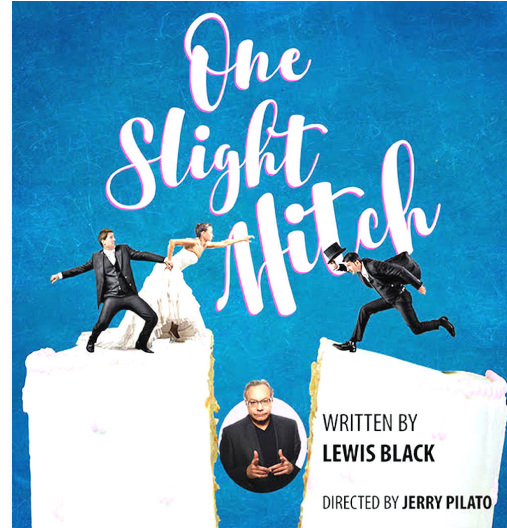
