The Legacy Fund supplements our rental income to enhance and maintain the Assembly's historic property. As we are a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization, contributions to the Fund are tax deductible as permitted by law.

Legacy Fund Success to date

2016 \$9,485 contributed by 47 members, including \$1,000 leading gift from Lori Fleet-Martin

2017 \$9,300 contributed by 45 members, including \$1,000 leading gift from Nancy Peckham

2018 \$3,050 contributed to date by 7 members, including \$1,000 leading gift from Sandy Perlatti

Total \$21,835

Capital improvements funded since the Legacy Fund Campaigns began:

Air Conditioning and Wi-Fi	\$16,858
Sidewalk Reconstruction	\$18,864
Monument Sign	\$ 9,800
Flooring	\$26,870
Total	\$72,392

The next building improvement proposed is the replacement of the stage curtain and room draperies to mitigate fire safety concerns, with an estimated cost of \$20,000.
