At Our April Meeting

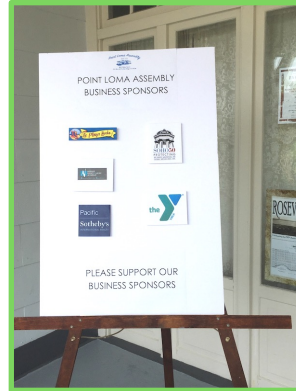


Carolyn Kutzke and Karen Kapp did it again! Bunnies and Easter decor throughout the hall.

To promote literary, social, educational, philanthropic, civic, and artistic work, and to restore and maintain the Assembly building at 3035 Talbot Street.

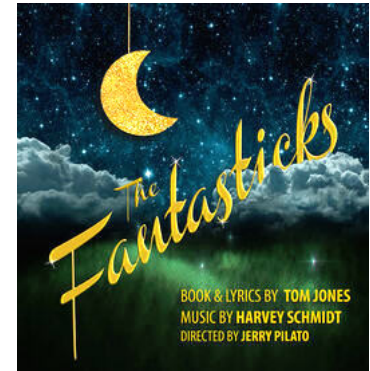


Renew Now!
