## What a difference a year makes!

In 2019 major improvements were completed to our historic building through the efforts and generosity of many Assembly members, including contributions to our Legacy Fund. The Legacy Fund was established to provide an opportunity for Assembly members and supporters to make charitable contributions toward the maintenance and improvement of the Assembly building and grounds. The Fund has been able to supplement rental income and grants sufficiently to provide our most recent improvements: new flooring, new stage curtains to mitigate fire safety concerns, and our first-ever monument sign on Talbot Street. In the past, the Legacy Fund has assisted with the installation of a new heating and air conditioning system and WiFi in the building, as well as the reconstruction of the sidewalk on Talbot Street to address pedestrian safety issues.

Assembly members will receive solicitation letters in October as part of the end-of-year 2019 Legacy Fund Campaign. We thought you would like to see how your donations are spent.

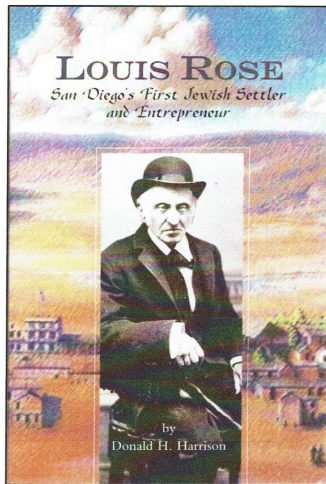
