## The Hubbs-Seaworld Research Institute

Our January 9 program by Dr. Pam Yochem was fascinating! She shared the important international work that her team at the Hubbs-Seaworld Research Institute is doing in our own back yard. The shared information was extensive but some of their work includes animal behavior through bioacoustics: how animals respond to natural and man made sounds. This type of data can, for example, inform the fishing industry on how to minimize entanglements and injuries to mammals during their deep sea fishing expeditions. Their work also includes the very important issue of sustainable seafood or aquaculture. She explained that the US has great potential to expand aquafarming as a way to provide large sources of fish for our population. Presently, the US imports most of the fish we eat. The organization also provides local, rapid first response to marine life in our community.
