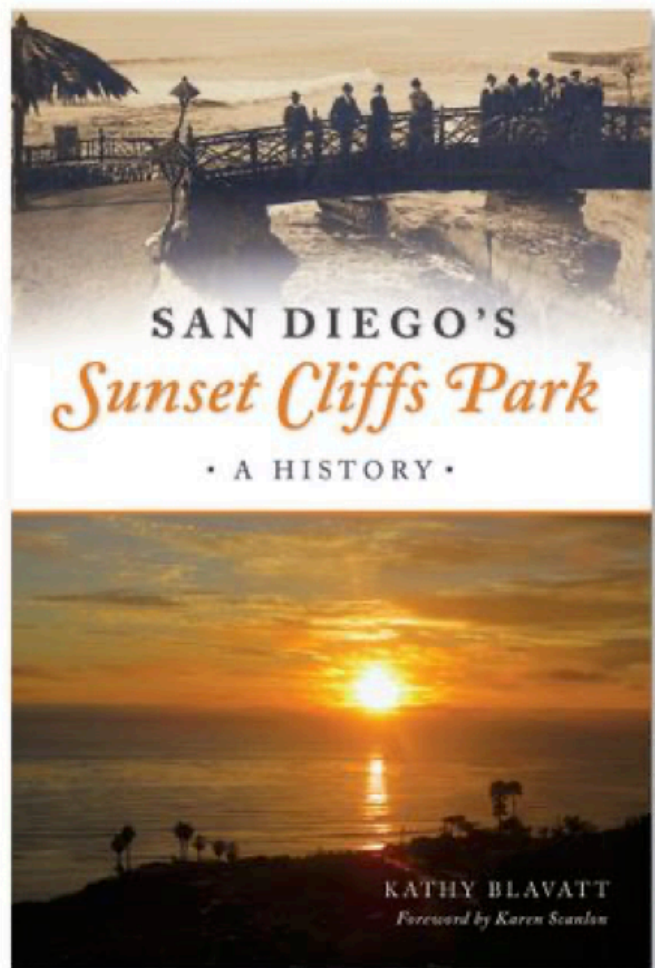
Our June 10 Meeting

Award winning Ocean Beach author Kathy Blavatt will tell us about her most recent book, *San Diego's Sunset Cliffs Park: A History*. She will speak about the many transformations of the park and what lies ahead for the storied cliffs.

Sunset Cliffs Park meanders along a mile and a half of San Diego's coastline, beckoning tourists and locals alike. These stunning cliffs inspired Albert Spalding, sportsman and visionary, to create a park in 1915 for all to enjoy.

Blavatt grew up on Sunset Cliffs Boulevard and she has been on the Ocean Beach Historical Society board since 2006. Her previous books include *Ocean Beach: Where Land and Water Meet*, and she coauthored Ocean Beach's *Weird, Wild and Wonderful*. These books include rarely seen photos and describe community highlights, assorted characters and spirited generations who have left their mark in history.
