

Dorothea Laub Music & Arts Center

On June 23, NTC Foundation (NTCF) celebrated the naming of Building 176 as the Dorothea Laub Music & Arts Center. Thanks to a Legacy Naming Gift from long-time ARTS DISTRICT Liberty Station patron and Point Loma Assembly Board Member, Dorothea Laub, through the Laub Family Trust in early 2020.

The building, prominently located at the main entrance to Liberty Station at Rosecrans Street and Roosevelt Road, is 21,179 square feet and is home to the San Diego Craft Collective, National Comedy Theatre, White Box Live Arts, California Ballet School, Monart School of Art, Young Lion's Jazz Conservatory and If I Was A Bird Yoga Studio. Built in 1942 for classrooms to train Navy recruits, it was renovated by NTCF at a cost of more than \$5.2 million in 2007. A ribbon-cutting ceremony was followed by a dance performance and celebration at The LOT.
