First and most importantly, we will soon start a complete replacement of our original plumbing system of cast iron pipes with new, modern PVC plastic pipes. Reaching Out to Vulnerable Youth

Tasreen Khamisa is the Executive Director for the **Tariq Khamisa Foundation (TKF)**, a San Diego non-profit with a mission to educate and inspire children in the restorative principles of accountability, compassion, forgiveness, peacemaking and support for safer schools and community.

In 1995, Tasreen's life was forever changed when her younger brother Tariq, a twenty year old student at San Diego State, was murdered during a gang-involved robbery. Her father saw there were victims on both ends of the gun and he began the foundation in an effort to stop youth violence. Tasreen relocated from Seattle in 1998 to join her father in creating an organization dedicated to making a difference in the lives of children.



A respected administrator and social justice leader with a BA in Sociology from the University of Washington, Tasreen is a dynamic public speaker and facilitator.

A proud mom of 3 kids, Tasreen has led TKF in becoming a nationally acclaimed and recognized organization. Being true to Tariq's philosophy of living by giving, she has found her path of forgiveness, joy, love and peace by living her passionate purpose to serve children.

At our February meeting...

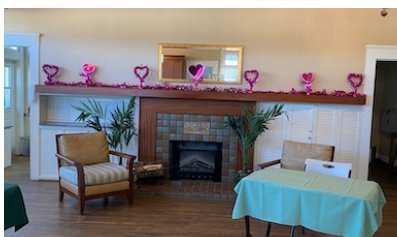
In collaboration with La Playa Trail Association, our meeting featured a presentation by Diane Kane on the Craftsman Bungalow.

The Nautical Museum Opens

Model shipbuilder and curator, Joe Frangiosa, is displaying his Nautical History Gallery and museum located in the historic Dick Laub NTC Command Center at NTC/Liberty Station. This 800 square foot gallery is a panoramic history of the U. S. Navy, its ships, and how they have evolved over time from the Revolutionary War period, through the Civil War, into the Spanish-American War, then World War I and World War II, including the beginning of naval aviation. Easter Sunrise Service at Cabrillo National Monument


Sunday, April 9, 2023

For the 72nd consecutive year, minus the two covid years, The Kiwanis Club of Point Loma will present an ecumenical Easter Sunrise Service at the Cabrillo National Monument. The services will be held in the lower parking lot, giving those who attend a great early morning panoramic view of San Diego Harbor and the city behind it.

Gates to the Monument will open at 6 a.m. with the non-denominational service beginning at 6:30 a.m. There is seating for approximately 500 attendees and the public is encouraged to arrive early. Please feel free to bring your own chairs and blankets. No pets please. The visitor and parking fees imposed by the National Park Service for visiting the Monument are not in effect for the service, but you will be asked to leave prior to the 9 a.m. park opening. A fellowship time with coffee, tea and pastries will be held immediately following the services.
