The Newest Performing Arts Destination is now at Liberty Station

Cygnnet Theatre and Arts District Liberty Station have partnered to transform the historic former Navy Building 178 at Liberty Station into a world-class performing arts venue for San Diego, creating a permanent home for Cygnnet Theatre. The Joan and Irwin Jacobs Performing Arts Center, affectionately nicknamed The Joan, will include two state-of-the-art theatre spaces (*one called the Dottie*) with spacious, ADA-accessible seating, a rehearsal space, an open-air lobby, two elegant bars, three landscaped patios, ample restrooms, and convenient parking. The Joan will bring 50,000 theatre attendees each year to patronize nearby businesses in Liberty Station, while providing space for numerous other performing arts organizations. The Joan is the home for Cygnnet Theatre and will foster live performance and elevate the arts in San Diego while engaging the entire community in an unparalleled cultural experience for generations to come. 
